VISITS

New consultation (medical, surgical or cosmetic dermatology)	\$325
Required for all patients seen for the first time at Aura Dermatologie or if the last visit was over 2 years ago.	
Includes a 20 to 30 minute visit with the care team.	
Includes a minor procedure if indicated based on the physician's clinical judgement. A minor procedure is defined as: a shave biopsy for a medical indication, the treatment of 3 lesions or less with cryotherapy, the treatment of 2 lesions or less with an intra-lesional corticosteroid injection.	
If a skin cancer screening examination is desired and does not constitute the chief complaint of the visit, it must be scheduled as a separate visit.	
If a consultation for hair loss (alopecia) is desired and does not constitute the chief complaint of the visit, it must be scheduled as a separate visit.	
New consultation or follow-up visit for skin cancer surveillance and screening	\$325
Includes a 20 to 30 minute visit with the care team.	
Includes dermoscopic examination and digital dermoscopic imaging of 3 lesions or less if indicated. Does not include total body skin imaging for nevi (mole-mapping).	
Includes a minor procedure if indicated based on the physician's clinical judgement. A minor procedure is defined as: a shave biopsy for a medical indication, the treatment of 3 lesions or less with cryotherapy, the treatment of 2 lesions or less with an intra-lesional corticosteroid injection.	
If a consultation for another dermatologic problem is desired (ex., acne, eczema, psoriasis, etc.), it must be scheduled as a separate follow-up visit.	
If a consultation for hair loss (alopecia) is desired and does not constitute the chief complaint of the visit, it must be scheduled as a separate follow-up visit.	
If a consultation in cosmetic dermatology is desired, it must be scheduled as a separate consultation.	
Follow-up visit in general dermatology	\$295
Available for established patients whose last visit was within 2 years.	
Includes a minor procedure if indicated based on the physician's clinical judgement. A minor procedure is defined as: a shave biopsy for a medical indication, the treatment of 3 lesions or less with cryotherapy, the treatment of 2 lesions or less with an intra-lesional corticosteroid injection.	
If a skin cancer screening examination is desired and does not constitute the chief complaint of the visit, it must be scheduled as a separate visit.	
Repeat visit	\$195
10 minute visit at the request and at the discretion of the physician only (cannot be requested by the patient).	
Ex., for a single lesion being monitored, for the treatment of simple warts with cryotherapy, for a simple intra-lesional corticosteroid injection. Any additional or new dermatologic issues will be addressed during a separate visit.	



Follow-up visit for intervention, cosmetic procedure or treatment with injectable The duration of the visit will be determined by the physician during the initial consultation based on the estimated time needed to complete the procedure. If other dermatologic problems (ex., acne, examination of moles, etc.) are addressed during a visit for intervention or treatment with injectables, the visit will become a follow-up visit in general dermatology or a skin cancer surveillance and screening visit depending on the reason for consultation.	\$0

INSURANCE

Consultations in private medicine are not covered by RAMQ and are rarely covered by private insurance in Québec.

Some treatments may be eligible to coverage by private insurers. We will provide you with a detailed invoice at the end of each visit, and we can give you a quote upon request.

We operate under a direct pay policy, which means that we do not work directly with insurance carriers, and we do not handle the submission of reimbursement claims to them. Fees – as detailed above – apply for completing insurance forms.

DURATION OF THE VISITS

We will always strive to provide you with the highest quality of care and address as many dermatological issues as possible in an efficient yet conscientious manner during the allotted time for the visit.

However, in order to respect everyone's time, we may sometimes recommend that certain procedures or other issues be addressed during a subsequent visit to ensure they receive the necessary attention and time they deserve.

Any person who is required to make a payment in contravention of the provisions of Article 22.0.1 of the Health Insurance Act has the right to claim reimbursement from the Régie de l'assurance maladie du Québec. A patient who believes that the amounts claimed from them after December 6, 2015, pertain to insured services under the meaning of the Health Insurance Act or expenses incurred for the provision of such services may, in writing within five years from the date of payment, claim reimbursement from the Régie de l'assurance maladie du Québec, which will then reimburse the amount if it is of the opinion that the billing was not allowed, and recover this amount from the professional or third party concerned.
